

Fed Releases Monetary Policy Report

The Federal Reserve's semiannual Monetary Policy Report to Congress indicates that financial conditions remain restrictive in mid-2024. While credit is generally available to households and businesses, elevated rates are suppressing financing activity. Bank lending has increased slightly in the first five months of the year but remains modest.

The report noted there are signs of vulnerabilities in the banking sector, particularly fair value losses on fixed-rate assets and stress in commercial real estate portfolios. Despite these concerns, banks continue to report solid capital levels and ample liquidity, with limited reliance on short-term wholesale funding.
